C. Eligibility criteria for participation in tender:

The technical evaluation will be done on the following parameters and offers from firms not conforming to any of these parameters will be rejected.

- 1) Bidder should have experience of at least five years in this field. The contractor should have professional trained personnel to carry out the pesticide treatment.
- 2) Firm should have valid license for carrying out such work or Registered with any Government organization/Autonomous body or should have undertaken in the field of pest control. Upload documentary proof.
- 3) The bidder should have a valid Trade License, PAN, Professional Certificate, IT statements, and GST Registration Certificate. Documentary proofs to be submitted.
- 4) Copies of Experience Certificate for similar type of work and at least one work completed for 3.0 Lakhs or more with one organization/Institute/Department/housing complex.
- 5) The firm should not have been blacklisted/debarred in any manner from any Govt. Department. A declaration on a stamp paper of Rs. 10/- should be uploaded/attached.
- 6) Complete tender document in all respects duly signed & stamped on each and every page as a token of acceptance of all the terms and conditions of tender shall be submitted along with EMD.
- 7) MSME certificate may be provided if applicable.

- 8) Self-attested copies of Work Orders/ Award letters along with certificates of completion in support of proof of experience for the works executed by the bidders during last 5 years ending on 31.03.2024. DCWAOA reserves the right to cross check the documents from the issuing department/ company.
- 9) VALID LICENSE: The bidder should have a valid license issued by State Govt./ Central Govt. Department /Central Pesticide Board to stock & use pesticides. A copy of the certificate has to be submitted in this regard.
- 10) The contractor should purchase all formulation/ pesticides to be used only from original manufacturer or their authorized dealer. The chemical should be of branded ISI marked products of a company. Manufacturer's authorizations for the chemicals used must be submitted.

Any Other area which is deemed to be necessary to complete the operation including Pump House, staircase, shafts, Lift rooms and elevator pits, corridors, roof tops or any other open spaces etc.

- 2. Methodology for Anti-Termite Treatment: Anti-Termite treatment shall cover measures for the total eradication and control of termites in residential complex. The chemicals used as well as procedure shall conform to IS code of practice for Anti termite treatment in buildings (IS 6313 part 3).
- 3. Mode of treatment: Anti-Termite treatment shall be done for building with RCC foundations or with load bearing walled foundations. The principle of the treatment is to create a continuous chemical barrier/Zone below and around the building/structure. The stages of treatment is mentioned below:
 - (i) Post Constructional Measures: Anti-termite treatment to the outside of foundation with chemical emulsion by admixing chloropyrofos emulsifiable concentrate (1% concentration) with water by weight, drilling 12mm. dia holes in concrete or masonry apron at an interval of 300mm. to a depth, of 300mm or more as close to the plinth wall as possible and the chemical emulsion pumped into those holes to soak the soil below at a rate of 2.25 litres per linear metre complete as per specification laid down in para 4.3.1.1 of Code I.S.-6313 (Part III)-1981.
 - (ii) Anti-termite treatment to the soil under floor with chemical emulsion by admixing Chloropyrofos emulsifiable concentrate (1% concentration) with water by weight including drilling vertically 12mm. dia holes at the junction of floor and wall at 300 mm interval to reach the soil below using hand operated pressure pump to squirt chemical emulsion into the pump to squirt chemical emulsion into the holes at the rate of one litre per hole. The holes shall be sealed after operation to match with the existing floor. The entire work is to be carried out as per specification laid down in para 4.3.1.4 of code I.S.- 6313 (Part-III)-1981.

- (iii) Anti-termite treatment to the junction of woodwork and masonry walls with chemical emulsion by admixing chloropyrofos emulsifiable concentrates (1% concentration) with water by weight including spraying at the points of contact with the adjoining masonry by drilling 6m. dia holes at a downward angle of about 45 degree at the junction of woodwork and masonry and squirting chemical emulsion into these holes at the rate of half litre per hole. The entire work is to be carried out as per specification of Code I.S.-6313 (Part III)-1981. The shutters are to be sprayed with emulsion. on both sides. All wooden fixtures like almirahs, racks etc. are also to be thoroughly sprayed with chemical emulsion. (Payment will be made on the basis of outside measurements of doors and windows)
- (iv) Spot application for insecticides using Aqua base spray for pest (for bugs, cockroaches, silverfish, spider, termites, mosquitoes) to walls and ceiling etc. with chemical emulsion by admixing chloropyrofos emulsifiable concentrates (1% concentration) with water by weight including spraying the emulsified chemical @ 0.5 litres per sq.m. by a hand operated pressure pump on wall surfaces, ceiling, electrical fixture, electrical lines including drilling holes inplaces where source of termite is detected squirting chemical solution into the holes and sealing the holes with cement grout. (Rate is per sq.m. of the floor area while actual work will be all walls ceiling, rack, partition and furniture).
- (v) **Treatment along /outside of foundations:** The soil in contact with the external wall of the building shall be treated with chemical emulsion at the rate of 7.5 l/m² of the vertical surface of the substructure to a depth of 300 mm. To facilitate this treatment a shallow channel shall be excavated along and close to the wall at 1.75 litres per running metre of the channel. Rodding with 12 mm diameter mild steel rods at 150mm apart shall be done in the channel if necessary for uniform dispersal of the chemical to 300 mm depth from the ground level. The balance chemical of 0.5 litre per running metre shall then be used to treat the backfill earth as it is returned to the channel directing the spray toward the wall surface. If there is a concrete or masonry apron around the building, approximately 12 mm diameter holes shall be drilled as close as possible to the plinth wall at 300 mm apart, deep enough to reach the soil below, and the chemical emulsion pumped into these holes to soak the soil below at a rate of 2.25 litres per linear metre.
- (vi) **Treatment of soil under floor:** The points where the termites are likely to seek entry through the floor are the cracks at the following locations:
 - a) At the junction of the floor and walls as a result of shrinkage of the concrete;
 - b) At construction joints in a concrete floor, cast in sections; and expansion joints in the floor.

Chemical treatment should be provided within the plinth area of the ground floor of the structure wherever such cracks are noticed, by drilling vertically 12 mm holes at the junction of floor and walls, constructional and expansion joints mentioned above at 300 mm interval to reach the soil below. Chemical emulsion shall be squirted into these holes using a hand operated pressure pump until refusal or to a maximum of one litre per hole. The holes shall be sealed. In general, the idea is to change the soil below the floor at the locations of cracks with toxicants so that termites in the soil are denied access through such cracks and openings in the floor.

4. CHEMICALS: Any one of the following chemicals conforming to relevant Indian Standard in water emulsion maybe used for the soil treatment in order to protect a building from termite attack.

<u>Anti-Termite Treatment on wood work</u>: Providing, diluting & injecting chemical emulsion for POST CONSTRUCTIONAL anti-termite treatment at points of contact of wood work by chemical emulsion Chlorpyriphos/Lindane (in oil or kerosene-based solution) @ 0.5 ltrs. per hole by drilling 6 mm holes at downward angle of 45° at 150 mm centre to centre and sealing the same.

Anti-Termite Treatment on below concrete or masonry: Providing, diluting & injecting chemical emulsion for POST CONSTRUCTIONAL anti-termite treatment: Along external wall below concrete or masonry apron using chemical emulsion @ 2.25 ltr. Per linear meter including plugging holes etc. With Chlorpyriphos 20 EC, Lindane 20 EC or imidacloprid 30.5 SC as per above spec.

5. Precaution: The chemicals described in this tender are insecticides with a persistent action and is to be regarded as highly poisonous. These chemicals can have an adverse effect upon health when absorbed through the skin, inhaled as vapours or spray-mists or swallowed. Persons carrying out chemical should know the precautions and exercise due care when handling the chemical whether in concentrate or in diluted form. The use of the chemical should be avoided where there is any risk of wells or other water supplies, pond water becoming contaminated. Contractor is fully responsible for any eventuality occurs to his workmen during execution of the work.

OTHER INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Vendor should visit and inspect the site for understanding the requirements. Vendor who submits quotations without visiting the site should not say later about their ignorance of the requirements. After opening the bids, no excuse will be entertained with regards to site conditions, security restrictions, etc.
- 2. Vendor should have previous track record of executing similar anti-termite treatment work.
- 3. Performance Security Deposit against the job to be held up to completion of warranty period and may be released in lieu of bank guaranty.

E. Terms and Conditions:

- 1) Tenderer should quote the consolidated rates for anti-termite treatment showing MRP and discounts thereon. HSN No. of the item(s) GST on rate should be mentioned separately. The total amount should be quoted both in figures and words. Request for inclusion of any tax/levy at later stage will not be entertained.
- 2) Vendor should visit and inspect the site before quoting. After opening the bids, no excuse will be entertained with regards to site conditions, security restrictions, etc.
- 3) The association (DCWAOA) reserves the right to accept or reject the lowest or any or all of the tenders without assigning any reason whatsoever.
- 4) The contractor should purchase all formulation/pesticides to be used only from original manufacturer or their authorized dealer. The chemical should be branded ISI marked products of a company. Materials & accessories used should be as per specification. The Chemicals along with its Invoice to be used are to be made available for inspection before its application.
- 5) The firm shall make his own arrangement for transportation of personnel, materials etc. at his own cost and expenses.
- 6) All the T&P is to be arranged by Contractor and nothing extra shall be paid on this account.
- 7) All the labour bye laws & regulations are to be followed by the contractor.
- 8) The contractor shall not sub let or appoint any sub-contractor for the work under any circumstances.
- 9) The contractor shall make his own arrangement for making electric connections to equipment like drill machine etc., if any. However, our electricians will help in identifying the required sockets for LT powerline near the job location.
- 10) The contractor shall be bound to follow the restrictions on the movement of labours at DCW campus due to security or any other reason(s). No claim shall be entertained on this account.
- 11) The contractor shall take all precautions to avoid accidents by exhibiting necessary caution boards, lights, flags etc. He shall be responsible for all the damages, accidents, caused due to negligence.
- 12) The contractor shall personally be responsible for violation of any guidelines and shall have to pay the fine/penalty imposed by appropriate authority. No claim on this account shall be entertained.
- 13) The timing and deployment of worker would be according to the time suited to the residents.
- 14) The contractor shall be fully responsible for safe custody of the material even if the materials are under double lock system.

- 17) The EMD may be exempted for the MSME/SSI vendors/service providers as per the Govt. rule.
- 18) The EMD amount will be forfeited in case, the qualified Bidder refuses to accept the purchase order or, fails to carry out the obligations mentioned therein or, if the project is left midway by the vendor.
- 19) No bidder is allowed to withdraw the tender. In case of withdrawal the EMD shall stand forfeited besides action being taken to black list the bidder.
- 20) The successful bidder has to submit the "Performance Security Deposit (PSD)", which is 10% of the contract Value, directly to DCWAOA account or in the form of bank guarantee from any nationalized/scheduled commercial bank drawn in favour of **Diamond City West Apartment Owners Association** enforceable at Kolkata, before releasing the final payment after successful installation and commissioning. - 23) Care of Buildings: Due care shall be taken by the contractor to avoid damage to the existing buildings during pest control work. The contractor shall be responsible for repairing all the damages and restoring the same to their original finish at his cost. He shall also remove at his costs all unwanted and waste materials arising out of his work from the site.
- 24) If any complaint is received from the resident feels that the treatment is not satisfactory then the said complaint shall be attended again by the contractor immediately free of cost/charge. In case of complaints are still received even after treatment the office administration will review the contract and may terminate the contract if necessary.
- 25) Contractor will be fully responsible if any eventuality occurs to his workmen during execution of work.
- 26) Standard force-majeure conditions would apply.
- 27) Warranty requirements: <u>5 years</u>. The firm shall ensure that there should not be recurrence of the problem during the period of 05 years after treatment. In case, the problem exists in such place/area, the contractor shall provide the service without any claims/charge in such cases.
- 28) **Dispute Resolution:** Disputes, if any with regard to the interpretation, execution and /or implementation of these terms and conditions shall vest exclusively in the President, DCWAOA whose decision shall be final and binding upon the parties. Disputes, if any with regard to the decision of the President, DCWAOA in the regard, shall be referred to Arbitration at the hands of a sole Arbitrator to be appointed by DCWAOA shall all proceedings in this regard shall be subject to the sole and exclusive jurisdiction of Courts of competent jurisdiction at Kolkata.
